WHAT ARE THE ISSUES?



"My mam goes to the same shop every day for her alcohol"

Young Person aged 14 – Mam is not in treatment and is still drinking.



THE QUESTION:

Can we do more as professionals to engage the wider community and local businesses to recognise the harms and to encourage support?



"I never spoke about my mam's drug problem, it's embarrassing."

Young Person aged 15 – Mam is not in treatment and is still using drugs.



THE QUESTION:

How can we support each other as professionals to encourage more young people to come forward for support? And break down the stigma?
